JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The prayer is for quashing the FIR No. 127, dated 19.07.2012 for offence under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Jhabhal, District Tarn Taran.

Learned State Counsel submits that there are two accused persons named in the FIR and only one of them is stated to have entered into compromise, assuming the same is to be accepted to be true. She thus, submits that there cannot be a partial compromise without associating all affected parties, since the sole plea of quashing the FIR is on the basis of compromise.

Therefore, in view of above, there is no merit in the petition and the same stands dismissed.
