1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?

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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a 70% permanently disabled person. He has lodged FIR No. 131 dated 1.12.2014 under Sections 324/323/34 IPC at Police Station Sujampur, District Gurdaspur, against respondents No. 4 to 7. It is stated that respondents No. 4 to 7 are the relations of respondent No. 8, who is a BJP councillor from Pathankot and that the police is not conducting a fair investigation.

In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot, to supervise the investigation of this case to ensure that a fair inquiry is conducted in the matter.

Petition is accordingly disposed of.

If the petitioner has still some grievance, he can approach this Court again.
