Though there is some reference of agreement dated 25.1.2014 as entered between the petitioner and respondent No.4 but learned counsel for the petitioner outrightly submitted that there is no such agreement and it is only the letter of intent dated 20.1.2014 (Annexure P-1), whereby exclusive right for marketing of residential and commercial plots in the Vardhman park were given to the petitioner. The letter of intent was followed by the letter of authority (Annexure P-2).

Though apparently it seems to be a dispute of civil nature, but without commenting upon the merits/nature of the case, respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, is directed to look into the contents of

the application dated 18.4.2015 (Annexure P-10) and the reminder dated 18.5.2015 (Annexure P-11) and to pass appropriate order within two months in accordance with law.
