INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner Karamvir Singh has preferred this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.102 dated 26.08.2014, registered at Police Station City Phagwara, District Kapurthala, under Sections 323, 325, 341, 308, 148 and 149 IPC (section 325 and 308 added lateron)

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner is named in the FIR. He is stated to be armed with iron rod. A specific injury with iron rod on the right thigh of the complainant has been attributed to the petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and the fact that weapon is to be recovered from the petitioner and he is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands dismissed.
