The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for issuance of directions to respondent no.2 i.e. the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to take appropriate action on the representation dated 21.4.2015 at Annexure P-6 that is stated to have been filed by the petitioner against respondent no.6 i.e. Harpreet Kaur.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

A representation that has been placed on record at Annexure P-6, has been perused minutely and which contains utterly vague allegations. No specific incident/date has been mentioned which would substantiate the assertion raised by counsel with regard to harassment at the hands of his in-laws.

In the light of such vague allegations no direction can be passed.

No basis for interference is made out.

Petition, accordingly, is dismissed.
