This petition has been moved by Surinder Singh under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.22 dated 26.3.2015 registered under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station Sadar, Rupnagar.

The petitioner is in custody since 26.3.2015 and alleged recovery is of 3 kilograms of poppy husk.

State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Darshan Singh, Police Station Sadar, Rupnagar has submitted that there is no other case registered against the petitioner nor he is a previous convict.

Charge-sheet in the case has not yet been filed in the Court as it is stated that the report of the Chemical Examiner is awaited. The trial has not even started and, therefore, will take quite some time to conclude.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits, the petition is allowed. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate.
