Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 67 dated 14.10.2011, under Section 323, 427, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga. Section 307 IPC had subsequently been added in the case. Quashing is prayed for on the basis of compromise.

Petitioners along with unnamed unidentified 15-20 people were allegedly involved in the case of assault registered at the instance of respondent No.3 Chamkaur Singh.

Parties were directed to appear before the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nihal Singh Wala to make statements regarding the compromise and a report has been received after recording the statements of the parties that the matter has been compromised voluntarily between the petitioners and the complainant. There does not appear to be any other

person effected by the compromise. Offence under Section 307 IPC has already been deleted.

Following the full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to the petitioners depositing a total sum of Rs.10,000/- with Punjab State Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh, within a period of one month from today.
