State counsel, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 while Mr. S.S. Brar, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 4 and 5 and files vakalatnama, which is taken on record.

Petitioners, Lovepreet Kaur @ Nasreem Bano and Kamaljit Singh, have moved this Court seeking protection on the ground that they have married on 23.05.2015 against the wishes of their parents and relatives.

Counsel for the petitioners has stated that the petitioners had moved a representation (Annexure P-5) before the Superintendent of Police,

Panchkula, to seek protection, but no action has been taken by the police.

In this view of the matter, Superintendent of Police, Panchkula, is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) and if there is any substance in it, may proceed further, in accordance with law.

The present order, however, shall not be deemed to be proof qua the factum/validity of any matrimonial alliance of the petitioners.

Parents of the girl are present and the couple apprehend danger to their life at their hands. The couple will, therefore, be taken to Protection Home, Sector 19, Chandigarh. Ms. Ashima Mor for U.T. Chandigarh is present who shall do the needful.

ASI Kuldip Singh, Police Station Sector 3, Chandigarh, who is present in Court, is called upon to accompany the petitioners for escorting them to the Protection Home.

A copy of the be order be given dasti to the State counsel under the signature of Special Secretary of this Bench.
