Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.32 dated 26.04.2013, under Sections 498-A, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of Mandeep Kaur respondent No.2 alleging that she has been maltreated by her husband petitioner No.1 and her in-laws petitioners No. 2 and 3.

Parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statement recorded. After recording the statement of the parties, a report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily.

Parties having finally resolved to amicably part company on the terms settled between them, no useful purpose will be served by prolonging the trial.

Following the full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
