SNEH PRASHAR, J.

Learned counsel representing the State has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Sh.Guarav Garg, Assistant Commissioner of Police(East) Amritsar, which is taken on record. It has been stated in the affidavit that appellant Mukhtiar Singh s/ o Pal Singh, resident of village Vallah, Police Station Sadar, Amrisar had died on 23.11.2003. The factum of death had been verified from the office of Municipal Corporation, Amritsar, which confirmed the death of Mukhtiar Singh and also supplied copy of death certificate, which is annexed with the affidavit. Statements of Mukhtiar Singh father- in-law of the deceased and Sukhwant Kaur, Councilor, Ward No.17 were recorded, who also affirmed that the appellant has died.

Since the appellant is reported to be dead and there is no other appellant in the instant appeal, the proceedings/appeal except for the sentence of fine against the deceased appellant stand abated and are hereby dropped.

Disposed of accordingly.
