This order shall dispose of two criminal petitions bearing

CRM-M No.17716 of 2015, captioned as “**Sandeep Singh @ Seepa v.**

State of Punjab” and CRM-M No. 20073 of 2015, captioned as “**Major**

Singh v. State of Punjab” as both these petitions are outcome of the one and same FIR No. 14, dated 27.03.2015, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 379-B, 356, 341, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Talwandi Chaudhrian, District Kapurthala.

2. Though, as per the allegations contained in the FIR, petitioners have been alleged to have caused injuries to Harjit Singh and Prabhdeep Singh but prima facie there is no corresponding injury as per the contents of their MLRs. Injuries, which fall within the ambit of Section 326 IPC, has been attributed to non-applicant i.e. Amrik Singh. Recovery of bottles, which are alleged to have been used during the course of occurrence has already been effected, during the investigation of this case. Petitioner-Sandeep Singh @ Seepa is cooling his heels behind the bars since April 21, 2015 whereas Petitioner-Major Singh is suffering incarceration since April 02, 2015 and are no more required for further interrogation. Moreover, completion of investigation of this case is likely to take sufficient long time.

3. Taking into consideration all these aspects of this case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, petitions are allowed and petitioner- Sandeep Singh @ Seepa and Major Singh are ordered to be released on bail, subject to their furnishing surety bonds, at the satisfaction of trial court/Duty Magistrate, Kapurthala.
