Instant petition has been preferred by Jaswinder Singh under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in case FIR No. 197 dated 17.10.2014 under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

2. While passing notice of motion order on May 27, 2015, following order was passed.

“Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter-alia, contends that no specific role has been attributed to the petitioner. The entire allegations unfolded by the complainant are false.

Notice of motion for 4.8.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. He shall join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer. He shall also comply with the other conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure”.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh submits that in compliance of order dated May 27, 2015, petitioner has joined investigation on July 31, 2015 and is no more required for further investigation.

4. In view of above, order dated May 27, 2015 is made absolute.

5. However, petitioner shall abide all the terms and conditions, as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
