After hearing learned counsel for the parties and going through the record of the case, this Court is of the considered opinion that in the

given fact situation of the present case, petitioner has been found entitled for bail pending trial. It is so said because petitioner is mother-in-law of the deceased-Pinki. Petitioner is inside the jail from 10.02.2015. Since the prosecution evidence is yet to start, trial is not likely to be concluded in the near future.

In view of the above and without commenting anything further in this regard at this stage, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, present petition is allowed. Petitioner is directed to be released on bail pending trial on her furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Rohtak.
