As per the information given by the counsel for the petitioner, charges have yet not been drawn up against the petitioner. He was allegedly found in possession of non-commercial quantity of salt diphenoxylate hydrochloride.

As per the instructions obtained by the State counsel from the police official present in Court, no other case is pending against the petitioner.

Since trial has yet not begun, the quantity is non-commercial and there is no other case pending against the petitioner, it is a case where bail should not be declined.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
