Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.110 dated 02.6.2013, under Section 21 of NDPS Act, P.S Patti, District Tarn Taran.

The petitioner was on bail and for his non-appearance before the learned trial Court on 20.1.2015, his bail bonds were cancelled and non-bailable warrants issued.
