Heard. Notice of motion.

State counsel, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

It is submitted that the petitioner had fallen down while doing job of welding in jail and his backbone was damaged. He cannot walk properly without support. Request is made for referring him for treatment to Civil Hospital, Bathinda, after constituting a medical board to assess his disability and the disease. A legal notice was also given to the Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda, on behalf of the petitioner.

It is, therefore, ordered that initially respondent No. 3, i.e. Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda, shall present the petitioner before respondent No. 4, i.e. Civil Surgeon, Civil Hospital, Bathinda, and the latter shall get the petitioner examined and if any disability is found, a medical board shall be constituted for assessing the extent thereof.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
