The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.27, dated 20.01.2014, under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B/406 IPC, registered at Police Station Badshahpur, District Gurgaon.

Counsel having argued the matter at some length prays for withdrawal of the present petition. He, however, raises another submission and undertakes that the petitioner would duly surrender before the trial Court and if, thereafter an application seeking regular bail is filed, the trial Court be directed to decide such bail application on the same very day.

As per prayer made by counsel, instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

It is, however, observed that in case, the petitioner duly

surrenders before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and thereafter files an application seeking regular bail, the trial Court would make every endeavor to expedite the hearing and disposal of the same.
