Notice of motion to Advocate General, Punjab. State counsel, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3, while Mr. P.S. Mirpur, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 4 and 5 and files vakalatnama, which is taken on record.

Petitioners, Manpreet Kaur and Gurwinder Singh @ Gurbinder Singh, have moved this Court seeking protection on the ground that they have married on 24.05.2015 against the wishes of their parents and relatives.

Counsel for the petitioners has stated that the petitioners had moved a representation (Annexure P-5) before the Senior Superintendent of

Police, Barnala, to seek protection, but no action has been taken by the police.

In this view of the matter, Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala, is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) and if there is any substance in it, may proceed further, in accordance with law.

The present order, however, shall not be deemed to be proof qua the factum/validity of any matrimonial alliance of the petitioners.
