Petitioner is seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty to the petitioner and his family members from respondents No.5 to 8 and further direction to respondents No.1 to 4 for taking appropriate legal action against the private respondents.

A legal notice has been sent to the Deputy Commissioner, UT Chandigarh (Annexure P-4) by the petitioner. Sohan Lal uncle of the petitioner executed a will on 30.03.1970. Rani Arora @ Joginder Rani @ Bholi Rani claimed that she was the legal heir of Sohan Lal. She was the adopted daughter of Sohan Lal and filed a suit for declaration that she was the adopted daughter of Sohan Lal, which was partly decreed by the lower court on 26.05.1995. Thereafter she filed an appeal in the appellate Court of Additional District Judge, Amritsar, which was accepted

vide judgement dated 20.07.2013. Thereafter she filed a succession that she was the owner of property bearing No.1010, Sector 19-B, Chandigarh and entries were changed by the Estate Officer, UT Administration in her name. The petitioner has made various applications for changing the ownership of above said property. On the basis of judgment and decree passed by the Court of ADJ Amritsar necessary applications are being made by the petitioner for getting the information under the RTI Act, 2005 before the Estate Officer.

This petition is disposed of by giving directions to the Deputy Commissioner, UT Chandigarh to look into the legal notice of petitioner (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law.
