1. Whether reporters of local newspapers may be allowed to see judgment ?

AMIT RAWAL, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. Seeking regular bail to the petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.133 dated 08.11.2014 under Sections 326, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station P.S. Sadar, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been compromised with the complainant and the compromise to this effect has been attached.

Mr. Yatinder Sharma, Addl.A.G., Punjab, on instructions from ASI Iqbal Singh submits that there is no other case registered against the petitioner but he faces ignorance with regard to the compromise arrived at between the complainant and the petitioner.

Be that as it may, present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib, subject to the

following terms:

- a). The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- b). In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh before the trial Court.
- c). He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
