Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.56 dated 6.3.2015 under Sections 420, 419, 406, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

On May 28, 2015, this Court has passed the following order:

for the petitioner.*

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in fact, it is a dispute between Jyoti @ Veerpal Kaur, wife and Amritpal Singh, husband, who have got married on 5.2.2014. The petitioner has simply facilitated the marriage with good intentions.

Notice of motion for 1.9.2015.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner, she shall be released on ad interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. However, she shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and no recovery is to be effected from the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Ajaib Singh, does not dispute this fact and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 28.5.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
