Petitioners have brought this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuing directions to respondents No. 3 and 4 to comply with the provisions under Section 160 Cr.P.C. and to give an advance notice of at least 10 days in case the petitioners are required to be called in connection with any case and to protect their life and liberty and not to harass them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no FIR has been registered against the petitioners.

The petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 3 to comply with the provisions under Section 160 Cr.P.C. and to give an advance notice of at least 10 days in case the petitioners are required to be called in connection with any case registered at the instance of wife of petitioner No. 3.
