This is the second petition filed by the petitioner for the grant of regular bail on merits, the first one having been dismissed as withdrawn on 15.5.2014.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the petitioner is in custody since 17.12.2013 yet the trial has not made any significant progress so far.

After obtaining instructions from HC Naresh Kumar, learned State counsel has informed the Court that out of the seventeen witnesses cited by the prosecution, five have already been examined while two given up and now the trial is slated for 30.7.2015 for examination of three more witnesses of the prosecution.

The petition is, hereby, disposed of with a direction to the State to complete the recording of its entire evidence within two months from the next date fixed before the trial Court.
