Prayer in the present petition filed u/s 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B IPC, in a case arising out of FIR No. 42, dated 28.03.2015, registered at Police Station, Sadar Dhuri, District-Sangrur.

Vide order dated 28.05.2015, while issuing notice of motion for today i.e. 03.07.2015, the interim protection has been granted to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation as and when required.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Sukhdev Singh, submits that pursuant to the order dated 28.05.2015, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the aforesaid categorical statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and order dated 28.05.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

However, petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
