Learned counsel for the parties state that compromise has been effected between the parties. Report in this regard has also been received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 28.05.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and the matter is compromised between the parties, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 28.05.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner will join the investigation as and when required by the police and will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation and will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. In case the petitioner does not comply with the conditions of compromise, liberty is granted to the complainant to get the petition revived.
