FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 01.06.2015 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st

Class, Amritsar (Duty) has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Priyanka and the accused persons petitioners No.1 and 2 namely Brijesh Mehta and Bal Krishan Mehta respectively, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise Ex.C1 has been arrived at between these three persons who have made statements voluntarily, out of their free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure. It has been further reported that two

accused namely Shivani Mehta and Preeti Mehta (petitioner No.3), who have already been declared as Proclaimed Offenders, have not appeared to make any statement.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, being a pure matrimonial dispute and the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is partly allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.10 dated 20.02.2009 registered at Police Station D Division, Amritsar City under Sections 498-A/406 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua petitioners No.1 and 2 namely Brijesh Mehta and Bal Krishan Mehta are quashed.

The petition stands allowed qua petitioners No.1 and 2 namely Brijesh Mehta and Bal Krishan Mehta, and is dismissed qua petitioner No.3 Preeti Mehta.
