SNEH PRASHAR, J.

The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 6 not to harass and pressureise the petitioner at the behest of accused/culprits to withdraw the case First Information Report No. 59 dated 31.3.2015 under Sections 376/ 511/ 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Division No.6, Ludhiana lodged by her.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that despite registration of First Information Report against the accused, they were not arrested by the police, rather she is being harassed by the police officials by raiding her house time and again. He had also moved a complaint (Annexure P-3), but till date no action has been taken on the same.

Without going into merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the complaint (Annexure P-3) and decide the same at the earliest.
