AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.21 dated 23.04.2015 registered under Sections 406 & 498-A IPC at Police Station Women Cell, Patiala.

Parties are present in person. With the intervention of learned senior counsel for the parties this dispute has been settled. It has been

agreed that the petitioner No.1 and the complainant will stay independently from the parents of the petitioner No.1 and the complainant has agreed that henceforth if there is any dispute between the parties the parents of the petitioner No.1 would not be implicated because now they have decided to stay independently. It has further been agreed that the petitioner No.1 shall go and bring the complainant from her house on 23.08.2015 (Sunday).

Learned senior counsel for the complainant has argued that though the complainant is not totally sanguine about the shape of things to come yet since the petitioner No.1 has agreed to keep her with him, she would not oppose the confirmation of the interim order.

In these circumstances, the interim order dated 28.05.2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands allowed in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
