1. Whether reporters of local newspapers may be allowed to see judgment ?

AMIT RAWAL, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. Seeking regular bail to the petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.24 dated 15.01.2015 under Sections 306, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station Focal Point, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is behind bars since January 19, 2015. The petitioner is nonetheless but is father-in-law of the deceased namely Ajay Kumar who unfortunately committed suicide on January 15, 2015 and marriage with daughter of the petitioner was few months old only which was contracted on September 28, 2014.

Mr. T.N. Sarup, Addl.A.G., Punjab, on instructions from ASI Bhupinder submits that the challan has been filed and the charges in the said FIR have been framed on March 09, 2015.

Since the trial may take more time, I deem it appropriate to allow this petition and grant regular bail to the petitioner to the satisfaction
Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.
