Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that prima facie it is a
case of acquittal, there being no direct sufficient evidence available against
the petitioner.

On the instructions of ASI Suresh Kumar, State counsel informs that the case is fixed for final arguments on January 17, 2015.

In view of the stage of the case, counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to raise all the pleas before the trial Court at the time of final arguments.
