NARESH KUMAR SANGHI, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 439, Cr.P.C., is for grant of bail to the petitioner-Karambir, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 120-B, 148 and 302 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, in a case arising out of FIR No.69 dated 01.05.2013, registered at Police Station, Radaur, District Yamunanagar at Jagadhri.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Darshan Singh, submits that the prosecution has already completed its evidence and after recording of the statements of the petitioner and his co-accused in terms of Section 313, Cr.P.C., the case before learned trial Court is fixed for leading the defence evidence and arguments, therefore, the verdict of the judgment by the learned trial Court is likely to be pronounced in a near future.

Though the learned senior counsel has pressed hard that the petitioner is behind the bars for the last more than two years, therefore, he may be released on bail, yet the facts of the case, would reveal that the petitioner has been booked for having committed serious offences punishable under Section 302, IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act and the case is near completion. Therefore, no ground for grant of bail to the petitioner, at this stage, is made out.

Dismissed.
