This is a petition moved under Section 439 of Criminal Procedure Code by Simranpreet Kaur seeking regular bail during the pendency of trial in case FIR No.523 dated July 25, 2012, under Sections 420, 406, 120-B, 34 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Model Town Panipat.

As per the allegations contained in the FIR, petitioner along with her co-accused, namely, Pardeep Kumar and Jai Bhagwan @ Bablu cheated the complainant and his family members and induce him to send his brother Satish Kumar to Canada and misappropriated a sum of Rs.9.5 lac received from them by way of inducement. Co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Pardeep Kumar and Jai Bhagwan @ Bablu have already been granted the concession of bail by the learned Sessions Judge, whereas request for bail moved by the petitioner was declined as challan was not presented by that date. Investigation is already complete. Challan has already been presented which is pending trial for June 11, 2015, the disposal of which is not

likely in the near future.

The case of the present petitioner is not on different footing than that of her co-accused, namely, Pardeep and Jai Bhagwan @ Bablu, offence complained of against the petitioner as well as her co-accused is also admitted by the Judicial Magistrate First Class.

Taking into consideration all these aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail at the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Karnal.
