The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'Code') seeking direction to respondents No. 1 and 2 to register FIR against respondents No. 3 and 4 for forging and fabricating the birth certificate of Ishanpreet Kaur, their daughter by filing false affidavit and documents.

Since there are other efficacious remedies available under law to the petitioners for seeking custody of minor child, if, they are parents as well as to avail remedy under Section 156 (3) of the Code for the alleged commission of forgery of any document, instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is not legally maintainable.

Accordingly, present petition is dismissed. However, petitioners shall be at liberty to move to the concerned authorities with all the pleas including the pleas taken in this petition.
