Prayer in this petition is for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondents No.2 to 4 by the Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur vide orders dated 29.04.2015 (Annexures P-2 and P-3).

As per allegations in the FIR Guddo @ Neelam is alleged to have given pushes and blows to complainant without any specification as to on which part of body the blows were inflicted and by what weapon. Ayub Masih and Vijay Masih are alleged to have raised *lalkara* to kill the complainant-party.

Apparently the role attributed to respondents No.2 to 4 is not that serious which may entitle the complainant-party to seek cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to them by the Court of

Sessions. There is no material on record to suggest that after grant of concession of anticipatory bail, respondents No.2 to 4 have misused the concession in any manner.

Finding no merit in this case, petition is dismissed.
