Prayer in the instant petition is for grant of regular bail on medical ground in case FIR No.45 dated 25.03.2015 under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sangat District Bathinda, in which recovery of 3 kgs of opium was made.

The case is still at the investigating stage.

Looking into the fact that the matter is still at the investigating stage, therefore, no ground to admit the petitioner on bail is made out at this stage.

Dismissed.

The Superintendent of Jail, Bathinda is directed to monitor the medical attendance of the petitioner by providing him specialised treatment for HIV positive and tuberculosis, if need be.
