Prayer in the present petition filed u/s 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory/pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in criminal case bearing FIR No. 57 of 15.06.2013, for offence under Sections 308, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station, Jodhan, District Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 28.05.2015, while issuing notice of motion for today i.e. 03.07.2015, the petitioner was directed to appear before the learned trial Court within a week and the trial Court was further directed to admit the petitioner on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 28.05.2015, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been admitted on bail.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Hardeep Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order dated 28.05.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
