Rahul Kundra and Karan Kumar have applied for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 116 dated 05.10.2014 under Sections 307/324/323/452/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code (in short "the IPC") and Sections 326/325 IPC added later on vide DDR No. 7 dated 01.11.2014 registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar.

As per allegations of the prosecution, Rahul Kundra gave five injuries which were simple in nature and Karan Kumar gave injuries which were on non-vital part.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhjit Singh, has stated at the bar that the matter has been compromised. He has further stated that Rahul Kundra-petitioner No.1 is in custody since 14.10.2014 and Karan Kumar-petitioner No.2 is in custody since 13.12.2014.

So, in view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition stands allowed. Both the petitioners namely Rahul Kundra and Karan Kumar are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial court.
