Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case DDR No.29 dated 02.05.2014, under Sections 324/323/452/326/148/149 IPC in FIR No.63 dated 01.05.2014, under Sections 452/324/323/325/326/201/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Kurali, District Mohali.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 02.06.2015, a Coordinate Bench of this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

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On instructions from ASI Talwinder Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 02.06.2015 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
