RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (Oral)

Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.20 dated 7.3.2013 registered under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station, Mullanpur Garibdass, District Mohali.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, fairly states that since the petitioner has absented from the court, he is ready and willing to surrender before the learned trial Court and the learned trial Court may be directed to consider his bail application sympathetically and also keeping in view the attending circumstances of the case.

Having heard the learned senior counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, petitioner is directed to appear before the learned trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and on his doing so, the learned trial Court shall consider his bail application after considering all the attending circumstances brought to its notice by the petitioner. Learned trial Court is further directed to decide the bail application of the petitioner at an early date by passing an appropriate order, strictly in accordance with law.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present petition stands disposed of.
