This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No. 4 to 7 as they have solemnized marriage against the wishes and consent of respondents No.4 to 7.

2. The petitioners moved representation (Annexure P-5) for getting the needful done but no action has been taken so far.

3. Notice to respondents No.1 to 3 only, at this stage.

4. On the asking of Court, Mr. J.S. Sekhon, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State of Punjab. Copy of the paper book be

supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Fatehgarh Sahib to look into the grievances of the petitioners unfolded by them in their representation dated May 22, 2015 (Annexure P-5) and if found necessary, take appropriate measures in accordance with law.

6. However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.
