This is a second petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No. 153, dated 14.08.2014, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station, Nathusari Chopta, Distt. Sirsa.

The earlier bail application i.e. *CRM-M-No. 5152 of 2015* titled as "*Banwari Lal Vs. State of Haryana*" was dismissed as withdrawn by this Court vide order dated 18.03.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, who is 73 years of age, is in custody since 15.12.2014. He is not keeping good health and is surrounded by many ailments. He further

contends that there is no evidence to show that the petitioner is knowingly made any false representation and co-accused, namely, Ram Kumar has already been granted concession of anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated *March 18, 2015* in *Crl. Misc. No. M-3618 of 2015* titled as “*Ram Kumar (Lumberdar) Vs. State of Haryana*”

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner is the main accused and he impersonated himself as Chanda Ram son of Sethu.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has committed the offence of impersonation and also the fact that earlier bail application of the petitioner was dismissed as withdrawn by this Court vide order dated 18.03.2015, no ground is made out for grant of regular bail.

Dismissed.
