The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 102, dated 1.12.2014, registered under Sections 399, 402, 411 of the IPC, at Police Station Panipat, District GRP Ambala Cantt.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that two of the co-accused who are similarly situated to the petitioner have been granted regular bail by this Court, vide orders (Annexures P-3 and P-4), and that the case of the petitioner is on similar footing.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from ASI Tara Chand, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny

the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Panipat. Petition stands disposed of.
