Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for directing respondent nos. 2 to 6 to take legal action against the accused persons, named in FIR No. 262, dated 08.06.2014, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506, 436, 427 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Tauru, District Mewat.
