MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition under Section under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR no. 244 dated 29.10.2013 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468 IPC read with Section 120-B IPC at Police Station Navi Baradari, Jalandhar

No ground to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner is made out as there are very serious allegations against him of identifying a person before the Land Acquisition Collector which resulted in release of compensation to an unauthorized person.

To the mind of this Court such an offence cannot be taken lightly considering the fact that a rightful owner has been deprived of the entire land and compensation both on account of misadventure on the part of the petitioner. A process of identification of a person before the competent authority is a serious matter and should not ordinarily be taken lightly as it results in unfavourable situation to rightful owner.

Hence, dismissed.
