The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.9 dated 15.01.2010, under Sections 406/420 IPC, registered at Police Station Kotwali Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length and the case paper book has been perused.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that inspite of registration of the FIR way back in the year 2010, petitioner has evaded the process of law and has also been declared a proclaimed person by the trial Court vide order dated 04.03.2015.

Conduct of the petitioner dis-entitles her to the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Dismissed.
