State counsel, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1.

The petitioner was admittedly declared proclaimed offender vide order dated 08.03.2013 passed by the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ajnala.

After more than two years, the petitioner has applied for anticipatory bail.

It is submitted that the co-accused were acquitted on 13.03.2013 and that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the Court below.

Even if other persons who had faced trial were acquitted, it will not mitigate the fact that the petitioner had fled and was declared proclaimed offender. He did not stop at that and waited for more than two

years to come to the Court.

No ground for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
