Report dated 31.3.2015 sent by learned SDJM, Samalkha has been received, whereby, after recording statements of the petitioners Gaurav, Suman Lata and Bhagwan Dass as well as of complainant Nidhi it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that there was purely a matrimonial dispute between the parties which has now been settled by way of compromise and that this compromise will go a long way to settle their future life and to bring about harmonious atmosphere, FIR No.819 dated 2.12.2011 under Sections 498-A,406,323 read with Section 34 IPC Police Station, Samalkha District Panipat and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
