SABINA, J

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.52 dated 25.04.2013, under Sections 402, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

Prosecution story, in brief, is that the complainant had not executed any agreement to sell his property with accused Joginder Singh nor had received the earnest money. Petitioner is one of the attesting witness to the said agreement to sell.

After thorough investigation of the case, challan has been presented against the petitioner and his co-accused. The plea taken by the petitioner is that he has been falsely involved in this case as he was a witness in a case titled “Kamaljeet Kaur versus Jagjit Singh” registered against

Assistant Sub Inspector Dev Raj. The said plea raised by the petitioner can be gone into by the trial Court at the time of decision of the trial. However, it would not be just and expedient to quash the criminal proceedings at the very threshold. Petitioner would be at liberty to take up all the pleas available to him, during trial, before the trial Court.

No ground for interference by this Court, is made out.

Dismissed.
