Notice of motion.

State counsel, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf
of respondents No. 1 to 3.

It is prayed in the petition that the complaint made by the
petitioner, copy of which is Annexure P-1, be got investigated from the
officer not below the rank of Superintendent of Police.

No such direction can be given because the Superintendent of
Police has various responsibilities and he is not supposed to conduct
investigation in such like cases. However, it is directed that Senior
Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, shall get the investigation
conducted from a police officer of some senior rank and dispose of the
representation of the petitioner. Even if civil litigation is going on, the
matter may be inquired into as the allegations made by the petitioner may
constitute a criminal offence.

The petition stands dispose of accordingly.
