Keeping in view that parties are known to each other and that this compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and to bring about harmonious atmosphere and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.239 dated 27.04.2015 under Sections 387, 506 IPC Police Station, Sector 5, Gurgaon and all

other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
